THE CHALLENGE

Access to high-quality early childhood education (ECE) and childcare is crucial for working parents, particularly during after school hours and in the summer. Yet these resources remain out of reach for many New Yorkers. Costs for these programs consume nearly half of an average New York City family's income. The achievement gap in New York City will continue to widen without access to early childhood education and safe, reliable childcare.

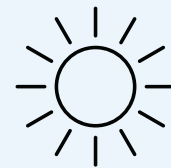
THE Y'S SOLUTION

ECE and quality childcare are powerful tools to mitigate the effects of poverty and close achievement gaps. By forming strategic partnerships and providing financial assistance, the Y reaches families who might not otherwise access these valuable services.

With childcare prices continuing to rise, funds to support Y programming are crucial. Many Y families rely on financial assistance, including 1 in 3 summer camp participants. Funds raised will enable these essential services.

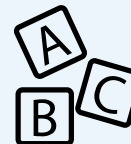

Summer is a critical time to provide children opportunities to learn new skills and explore their world. YMCA camps effectively combat summer learning loss through fun and engaging experiences.
